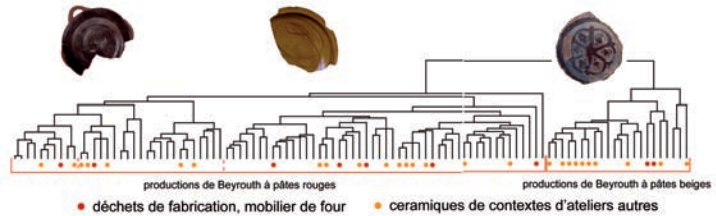


**POMEDOR & The Levantine Ceramic Project – 2014 Mini-Workshop 3
